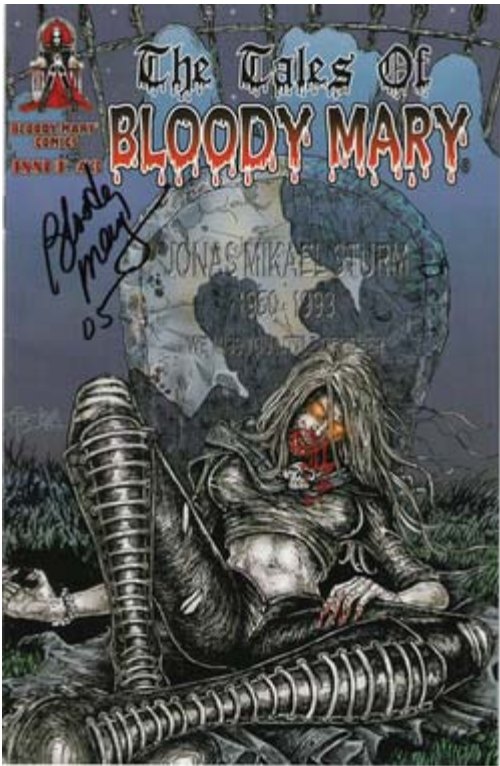


Title: The Tales of Bloody Mary # 3
